- 1. The Chairman of Board of Governors (BoG) has welcomed the Members of the Board of Governors (BoG) and mentioned agenda points to be discussed. He has also clarified that after thorough discussion among the members on each point, decisions will be resolved.
- 2. The member secretary and Principal of the college has submitted to the members that the resolutions taken during the 23rd BoG meeting are implemented subjected to the limitations from various offices.
- 3. The member secretary has presented the reformed Governing Body members details for approval by the committee. He mentioned that Dr. Sahu Chatrapati is substituted in the place of Dr Rama Mohana Reddy and Shri Sriram Srikanth is substituted in the place Shri O. Venkateswarlu. The Committee has approved the same.
- 4. The status of admissions for the year 2022-23 have been presented to the committee as given below.

- 6. The committee has approved the proposed variations in intake for the academic year 2023-24 and advised the institute to apply for NOC from JNTUH and UMS.
- 7. The committee has approved the submission of data to AICTE portal by including suggested variations for the year 2023-24.
- 8. It is informed to the committee that 3rd cycle renewal inspection by NBA for the courses B.Tech.-CSE and ECE are due and the first time NBA accreditation pre qualifier for B.Tech.-IT has been submitted and accepted by NBA. Further, the member secretary has mentioned that they are in the process of submission of eSAR for NBA accreditation for B.Tech.-Information Technology.
- 9. It is also submitted to the committee members that the application for the proposal for Autonomous status was submitted to UGC, New Delhi during April, 2022 and waiting for further process from UGC. It is getting delayed because of certain reforms are happening at UGC end for conferring autonomous status for the institutions in the country.
- 10. AQAR for the year 2020-21 is ready for uploading in to NAAC website and the same for the year 2021-22 is under preparation. Both these reports will be submitted before the last date given by NAAC which was in the month of February 2023.
- 11. The college has formed the academic counsel and BoS for the departments and are approved.

- 14. The details of placements as on 09-01-2023 for the outgoing batch in the year 2023 are presented to the committee. It is clear that more than 60% of the students got placed right in final year first semester and over 15% of the students have got admissions in abroad universities. The committee has appreciated the performance of the institute.

- 15. Memorandum of understanding signed between MRITS and companies to enhance their knowledge and prepare themselves for industry ready are presented to the committee.
- 16. Summary of various events FDPs, Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, guest lectures for A.Y 2021-2022 was presented to the members and committee satisfied with various events conducted.
- 17. The details of faculty members attended FDP, Research articles, Books/Book chapter published and patents filed were presented to the members.
- 18. Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) was established in A.Y 2021-22 and Quarter IV events report submitted in IIC portal and received one star. IIC events for A.Y 2022-23 Quarter I 13 events conducted.
- 19. Stakeholders feedback analysis for the A.Y. 2021-22 was presented with action taken report. Departments are planned to organize seminars, add on programmes, guest lectures and workshops to fill the curriculum gaps identified.
- 20. Budget utilization of A.Y 2021-22 and budget allocation for A.Y 2022-23 are presented to the members and members approved the same.
- 21. The Internal audit done for the year 2021-22 is presented to the committee and the committee has accepted the same.
- 22. Presented the events organized by Women Empowerment Cell.
- 23. Reported the NSS activities in the A.Y 2021-22. Committee appreciated and advised to continue the NSS events more effectively.

It is submitted to the members that for Capacity building and Skills enhancement, the students are offered the following: a) Soft skills training, Language and Communication skills enhancement practice in laboratories, Life skills, Yoga skills, Physical fitness skills, Health skills, Hygiene skills, ICT and Computing skills etc. Further, it is mentioned that the students are also made as members in all committees for administrative, academic, Grievance and Redressal, Religion based, Gender based, Anti Ragging etc.
- 31. Library And information center is updated with 210 book titles and 950 volumes. Following expenditure from the A.Y.2021-22 to till date of Library is Presented to committee.
- 32. The committee has also appreciated the encouragement to staff members by the management of the institution in terms of offering rewards for publication of papers, books/book chapters, patents etc. Rewards are also extended to the faculty members for producing 100% pass percentage in the semester end results.

All the members of the committee have unanimously agreed for resolving the above points and expressed their satisfaction over the administrative and academic policies of the college and recommended to follow the same in future.
