1. The Chairman of Board of Governors (BoG) has welcomed the Members of the Board of Governors (BoG) and mentioned agenda points to be discussed. He has also clarified that after thorough discussion among the members on each point, decisions will be resolved.
2. The member secretary and Principal of the college has submitted to the members that the resolutions taken during the 23rd BoG meeting are implemented subjected to the limitations from various offices.
3. The member secretary has presented the reformed Governing Body members details for approval by the committee. He mentioned that Dr. Sahu Chatrapati is substituted in the place of Dr Rama Mohana Reddy and Shri Sriram Srikanth is substituted in the place Shri O. Venkateswarlu. The Committee has approved the same.
4. The status of admissions for the year 2022-23 have been presented to the committee as given below.

6. The committee has approved the proposed variations in intake for the academic year 2023-24 and advised the institute to apply for NOC from JNTUH and UMS.
7. The committee has approved the submission of data to AICTE portal by including suggested variations for the year 2023-24.
8. It is informed to the committee that 3rd cycle renewal inspection by NBA for the courses B.Tech.-CSE and ECE are due and the first time NBA accreditation pre qualifier for B.Tech.-IT has been submitted and accepted by NBA. Further, the member secretary has mentioned that they are in the process of submission of eSAR for NBA accreditation for B.Tech.-Information Technology.
9. It is also submitted to the committee members that the application for the proposal for Autonomous status was submitted to UGC, New Delhi during April, 2022 and waiting for further process from UGC. It is getting delayed because of certain reforms are happening at UGC end for conferring autonomous status for the institutions in the country.
10. AQAR for the year 2020-21 is ready for uploading in to NAAC website and the same for the year 2021-22 is under preparation. Both these reports will be submitted before the last date given by NAAC which was in the month of February 2023.
11. The college has formed the academic counsel and BoS for the departments and are approved.
